ProComplianceWare Shares 2014 Regulatory Compliance Management Trends

– Revenue is forecast to grow during the next five years to 2018 –

MADISON, CT– (January 7, 2014) – Top trends in regulatory environmental compliance for 2014, according to ProEnvironmentWare, Inc., a developer of Web-based regulatory compliance solutions, include increased growth over the next five years. The industry, now in its growth stage, reports revenue at \$15 billion, with annual growth between 2010 and 2015 estimated at 0.1 percent. Demand from both the public and private sectors for environmental consultants will bolster industry revenue over the next five years as companies seek to reduce their carbon footprints.

This is due to growth faster than that of the overall economy, new businesses entering the industry, along with the rate of technological changes prompting new services.
